

PICKLEBALL CHALLENGE COURT RULES



Northview wants to ensure everyone can enjoy the courts. Please adhere to these rules when the courts are full.

Thank you for your cooperation.



Games are played to 11 points, win by 2.



If there are up to 4 players waiting to play, winning partners can stay on the court for 3 consecutive games. Losing partners get priority to put their paddles back in the court queue before winning partners who have won 3 consecutive games.



Losing partners should rotate off the court if there are up to 4 paddles in the queue. The 2 players at the top of the queue will challenge the winners.



If winners are staying on the court and there is only 1 paddle in the queue, the challenging player will team with one of the losing players.



If there are 5 or more players waiting to play, then all 4 players must rotate off each court.
