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## CHRONICLES OF NARNIA

### STEP ONE: *"And the icebreaker is ...."*

- » Have someone open and read one of the **icebreaker** envelopes.
- » Go around the circle to **answer**.

**Leader note:** It does not matter which envelope is opened on any given week. Have fun with it ... kind of like opening the envelope at the Oscars to announce the winner.

### STEP TWO: *SOAP Bible Study*

- » Pass out the **SOAP** Bible Study sheets and pens to everyone.
- » Go around the circle and have people **read** one verse out loud.
- » Take a few minutes to silently write down any thoughts from the **passage**.
- » **Discuss** observations from the passage.

**Leader note:** Have a few observations of your own that you can use. For example, after allowing others to answer, you might say, "I thought Ananias' response was interesting. He was kind of like, 'God, are you sure about this'. What jumped out to you guys?"

### STEP THREE: *Movie Time*

- » Play the **video**.

**Leader note:** Test the technology ahead of time to make sure everything works.



#### STEP FOUR: *Discussion Questions*

**Leader note:** Success is getting people to engage with the questions. It's okay if you don't get to all of the questions.

1. What thoughts or insights do you have from the weekend message or the video teaching?
2. Why was Saul so laser-focused on persecuting Christians?
3. How did Saul's past and his conversion experience impact his future ministry?
4. What characteristics or qualities do you observe about God in this passage?
5. God asked Ananias to do something that felt very risky. When has God called you to do something that stretched you?
6. We live in an age of relativism where the prevailing mindset has changed from, "Is it true, to 'Is it true for you?'" How has this shift impacted our culture?
7. How do you spiritually engage with people in a relativistic culture?
8. In what situations or seasons of life do you think people are most open to the gospel?
